SEND KIOSKS: U.S. PRIVACY NOTICE

Effective Date: January 1st, 2024

SEND Kiosks (“SEND Kiosks”) respects your concerns about privacy. This U.S. Privacy Notice describes the types of personal information we collect about individuals on SEND Kiosks (<https://sendkiosks.com>), how we may use the information, with whom we may share it, and the choices available regarding our use of the information. The U.S. Privacy Notice also describes the measures we take to safeguard personal information and how individuals can contact us about our privacy practices.

INFORMATION WE OBTAIN

When you visit our Site, we may obtain personal information about you in various ways. The types of personal information we may obtain include:

Contact information, such as name, postal address, email address and telephone number;

If you are seeking career opportunities with SEND Kiosks via the Site, we request information such as name, postal address, email address, telephone number, and Skype address, and you may also choose to submit your resume, cover letter and additional files; and

Personal information contained in the content you submit, such as through our “Contact” feature.

AUTOMATED COLLECTION OF DATA ON THE SITE

When you visit our Site, we may obtain certain information by automated means, such as cookies, web server logs, web beacons, and other technologies. “A “cookie” is a text file that websites send to a visitor’s computer or other Internet-connected devices to uniquely identify the visitor’s browser or to store information or settings in the browser. A “web beacon,” also known as an Internet tag, pixel tag or clear GIF, links web pages to web servers and their cookies and may be used to transmit information collected through cookies back to a web server.

The information we obtain in this manner may include your device IP address, identifiers associated with your devices, types of devices, web browser characteristics, device characteristics, language preferences, clickstream data, and dates and times of visits to the Site. These technologies help us (1) remember your information so you will not have to re-enter it; (2) track and understand how you use and interact with our Site; (3) tailor the Site around your preferences; (4) measure the usability of the Site; (5) understand the effectiveness of our communications; and (6) otherwise manage and enhance the Site.

Your browser may tell you how to be notified when you receive certain types of cookies or how to restrict or disable certain types of cookies. Please note, however, that without cookies you may not be able to use all the features of our Site. Our Site is not designed to respond to “do not track” signals received from browsers.

We may use the information we obtain on the Site to:

THIRD-PARTY WEB ANALYTICS SERVICES

We may use third-party analytics services on our Site, such as Google Analytics. The service providers that administer these services use automated technologies to collect data (such as email and IP addresses) to evaluate the use of our Site. INFORMATION SHARING

We do not disclose personal information we obtain about you, except as described in this U.S. Privacy Notice. We may share your personal information with our (1) subsidiaries and affiliates and (2) service providers who perform services on our behalf, such as data analytics services, for the purposes described in this U.S. Privacy Notice. We do not authorize our service providers to use or disclose the information except as necessary to perform services on our behalf or comply with legal requirements.

We also may disclose information about you (1) if we are required to do so by law or legal process (such as a court order or subpoena); (2) in response to requests by government agencies, such as law enforcement authorities; (3) to establish, exercise or defend our legal rights; (4) when we believe disclosure is necessary or appropriate to prevent physical or other harm or financial loss; (5) in connection with an investigation of suspected or actual illegal activity; (6) in the event we sell or transfer all or a portion of our business or assets (including in the event of a reorganization, dissolution or liquidation) or (7) otherwise with your consent.
